# CHARTWELLS - MEAL COSTS

UNFORTUNATELY. CHARTWELLS CATERING HAVE INFORMED US THAT THEY ARE INCREASING THE PRICE OF SCHOOL MEALS FROM MONDAY 17TH APRIL, 2023.

AS A RESULT. THE COST OF SCHOOL MEALS FOR CHILDREN IN OUR NURSERY. Y3 AND Y4 CLASSES WILL INCREASE FROM £2.45 TO £2.70. THIS MEANS A WEEKLY CHARGE OF £13.50 WHEN WE RETURN FROM THE EASTER BREAK.
