3	Finances	DD advised that there is £1900 in the account plus some petty cash to go in following money raised at the Dads' walk, Apple Day, HK's raffle and the barbecue/bake sale from the sponsored run. DD advised the treasurer handover is complete.	
4	School Wishlist	JPV advised that the bill for the school field and money for the headphones is due to be paid. DR advised that the current wish list included subscriptions to Spelling Shed to cover class 2 and 3 (Over £70), a new nativity play at around £50, a Roman soldier visit at £90 for half a day for Class 3. DR asked for the Class teacher pots for the term and an additional general pot for various items that arise. All agreed to fund. DR advised that a long-term project would be to develop the playground to improve the ground, fence off the football area as well as updating the equipment. 		into other funding such as grants available and the Tesco scheme. KR advised that Walton Homes donated to ACE and would check this with Sue Green. It could also be wise to ask about the details of the White Hart's new playground. The front of the school was discussed to make better use of the space and the possibility of parent help to take out some of the planters.
