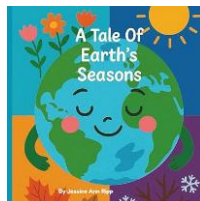
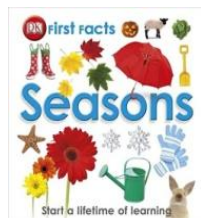
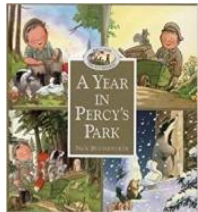
How does the earth change through the year?

Essential/Core Vocabulary

Season - A time of the year when the weather changes
Weather - What it is like outside (sunny, rainy, windy)
Spring - When it starts to get warmer and flowers grow
Summer - The warmest time of the year with lots of sunshine
Autumn - When leaves fall and it gets colder
Winter - The coldest time of the year, sometimes with snow
Hot - Very warm
Cold - Not warm, you might feel chilly
Change - When something becomes different

Key Knowledge

- The year is made up of four seasons.
- The seasons are spring, summer, autumn and winter.
- The weather changes in each season.
- In summer it is usually hot and sunny.
- In winter it is usually cold.
- The environment changes in each season (e.g. leaves fall, flowers grow).
