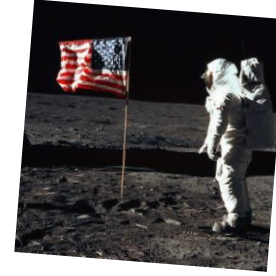


What Have We Learned from the Past?

Why do we remember explorers from the past and present?



Vocabulary

explorer	A person who travels to discover new places.
past	Something that has already happened.
present	What is happening now.
timeline	A way of showing events in the order they happened.
event	Something that happens in history.
change	When something becomes different

In Early Years I learned about:

- We learned about people who help us now and people who helped others in the past.
- We learned that some people are remembered because they made a difference to the lives of others.
- We learned about the difference between the **past** and the **present**.
- We learned to compare people and events from different times using historical vocabulary.

Lessons in this unit:

Lesson 1: To know that Neil Armstrong is an explorer from the past and Tim Peake is an explorer from the present.

Lesson 2: To know that Neil Armstrong is remembered because he was the first person to walk on the Moon.

Lesson 3: To know that Tim Peake is remembered because he travelled into space and worked on the International Space Station

Lesson 4: To know that Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake were both space explorers but lived at different times.

Lesson 5: To know that space exploration has changed over time because technology has improved.

Lesson 6: To know that sources such as photographs, videos and objects help us learn about explorers.

Lesson 7: To know that explorers from the past and present are remembered for their important achievements.

Endpoint outcome: To create a comparison poster, timeline or presentation that explains why Neil Armstrong and Tim Peake are remembered today.
