Special - Important and loved.

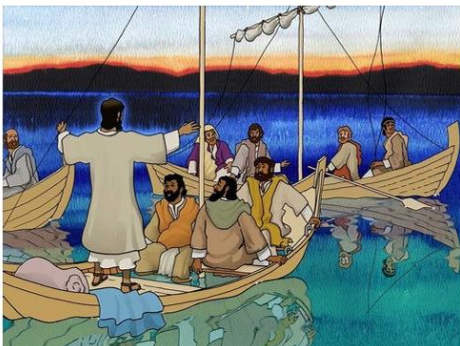
Kindness - Caring and helping others.
