Disciple - One of Jesus' special friends.

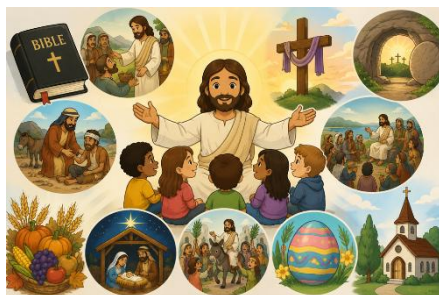
Cross - A symbol reminding Christians of Jesus and God's love.

Links to our core values...

Love - Children reflect on how Jesus showed love through His teachings, miracles and care for others.

Friendship - Children remember how Jesus chose disciples, taught people to help others and showed the importance of kindness and friendship.

Respect - Children recognise that Christians have special beliefs, stories and celebrations and learn to respect the beliefs of others.

- Jesus had special friends called disciples.
